1. Call Family Services of Western Pennsylvania at **724-335-9883 ext. 5517 and speak with Jamie Husar.**
2. You will need your child's social security number and insurance information when you call.
3. If you are the guardian of the child then you will need to have paperwork available at the first appointment so that your child can receive services.
4. Confirm with Jamie Husar that you are calling to set up school -based therapy at Gateway School District.

There are many reasons to consider counseling/therapy (here are a few of those reasons):

1. A change in life situation (Divorce, death, separation, incarceration, moving, etc.)
2. Behavioral concerns that are interfering with your child's ability to succeed at home and at school.
3. General anxiety, fear, depression, depression, anger, loss of control, and lack motivation.
