



Every February 2 since 1887, Punxsutawney Phil in Pennsylvania has made his weather prediction. If it's sunny and he sees his shadow, it's said we'll see six more weeks of winter. If it's cloudy and he doesn't see his shadow, it's said to mean an early spring.

The year which has 366 days is called a leap year. That extra one day is added to the shortest month of the year, i.e. February. When a year has February 29 in its calendar, it is termed as a leap year. This year occurs every four years.

Anyone can be born in a leap year but people born on february 29 are called leap day babies. Leap day babies can celebrate their birthdays on february 28 or March 1 except in a leap year when they can actually celebrate!



A year is the total time taken by the Earth to orbit around the Sun once. It takes the Earth 365 1/4th days (5 hours, 48 minutes and 46 seconds) to make one orbit around the sun. But we calculate every year as only 365 and not the few hours left. So, these leftover hours add up every four years and eventually add one extra day to our calendar. Adding a day every four years matches our calendar with the solar year.
